


Joanne Kathleen Rowling was born in Chipping Sodbury in 1965. She spent her childhood near Bristol. Two of the children she played with were called Potter, a name she liked very much. At school she wasn't good at sports, but she was very imaginative and very interested in languages and she wroteher first story when she was five or six years old. When she was nine years old, she had a school teacherwho terrified her.

After school she studied French at Exeter University and spent one year in Paris. In 1992 she went toPortugal to teach English. Her marriage toa Portuguese TV journalist ended in divorce and she returned to Britain with her daughter. They settled in Edinburgh. When she was out of work and she spent her time writing.

The idea of telling the story of a boy who was a wizard came to her in 1990. She continued working on the story for several years and finished her novel when she was in Edinburgh. Then she sent it to many publishers who reject it. Finally in 1996, Bloomsbury Children's Book bought her novel Harry Potter and the philosopher's Stone.
